

Hamilton Manufacturing Metrics

Job Counts

- Including employment and self-employed, Hamilton houses approximately 28,294 jobs in manufacturing.
- Hamilton's jobs in manufacturing have posted a slight increase since the 2019, pre-COVID-19, benchmark of approximately 27,966 jobs in manufacturing. Between 2019-2024, manufacturing jobs in Hamilton have increased by approximately 1.2%.¹

Employment Counts

- As part of an integrated regional economy, **approximately 42,900 people living in the Hamilton Census Metropolitan area were employed in manufacturing** jobs across Ontario in 2024.
- Approximately **78,900 people living in the Hamilton Census Metropolitan area were employed in goods-producing industries**, including manufacturing, in 2024.²

Manufacturing Imports/Exports

- The 2023 estimated export value of goods that can be linked to specific entities in the Business Register operating in the Hamilton Census Metropolitan Area totaled approximately \$11.731 billion; manufacturing accounted for approximately \$9.908 billion of this figure.³
- The 2023 estimated import value of goods that can be linked to specific entities in the Business Register operating in the Hamilton Census Metropolitan Area totaled approximately \$24.028 billion; manufacturing accounted for approximately \$8.511 billion of this figure.⁴
